

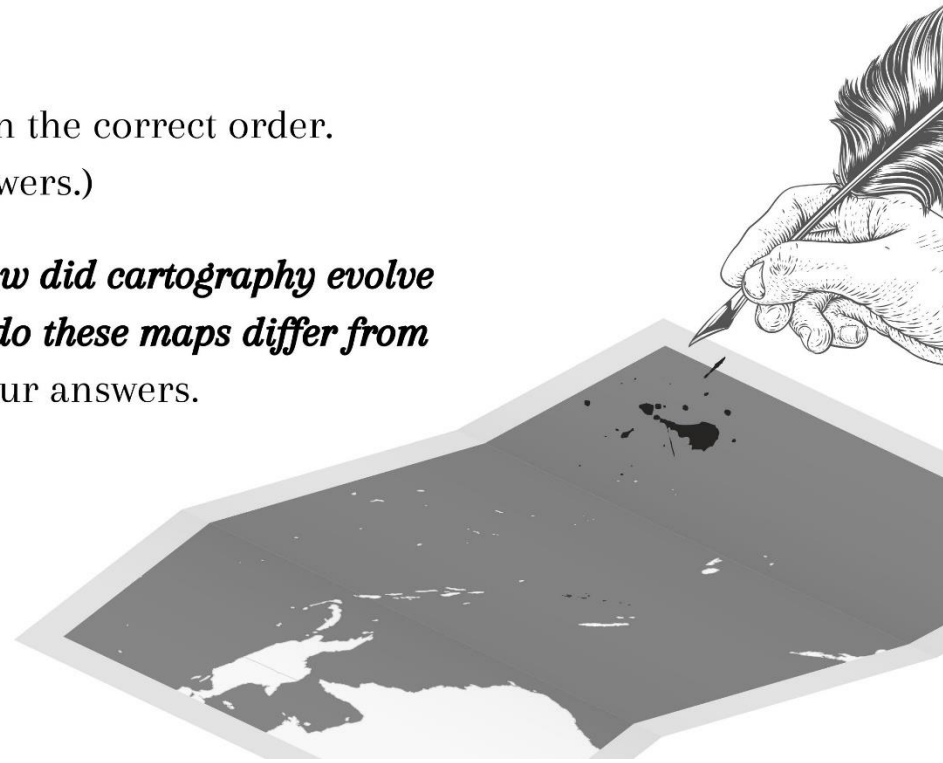
# CARTOGRAPHERS ACROSS TIME
